The Lehigh Township Police Department is seeking your financial support in a project for housing of stray and lost dogs. Currently, Lehigh Township maintains two dog kennels. These kennels are in disrepair, and offer dogs no real shelter during inclement weather. The current kennel is an exposed fenced-in run. During the cold winter months dogs are exposed to the frigid temperatures, high winds, snow or rain. Often times during the summer, the dogs are exposed to extreme heat and sun. Additionally, we often run into periods where we have too many dogs for our two kennel runs. Housing multiple dogs in a single run has proven to be dangerous for the dogs as well as officers attempting to handle the dogs.

Lehigh Township Police Department is seeking financial sponsorship to build a new three run, indoor-outdoor kennel. The kennel would be constructed locally and provide the dogs with the appropriate shelter during the harsh northeast weather that we have all know can have grave consequences to stray dogs.

Our goal is to raise \$10000.00 to construct the proper kennel with 3 indoor/outdoor runs. The indoor area will be climate controlled during extreme weather conditions. The construction will allow for enough space and the free movement for the largest dog size.
