Victim Procedures:

1. File a police report. Complete an Identity Theft Complaint form.
2. Complete an Identity Theft Affidavit and send to all compromised accounts. This form may be obtained from the creditor or Federal Trade Commission.
3. Close all compromised accounts.
4. Place a fraud alert with Credit Bureaus and obtain a copy of your credit report.
5. Request credit bureaus block all fraudulent information.
6. File a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission.

Request a fraud alert be put on your credit report. There are two types. The first is an initial fraud alert which is active for at least 90 days. The second is an extended fraud alert which can last up to 7 years.
