

Lehigh Township Yard Waste Facility

Card Access Regulations

Annual Fee: \$10 (Cash or check payable to Lehigh Township)

The access card for the yard waste site will provide residents with access to the site from 7 AM to sunset, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The site is closed on Wednesday, Sunday, and Township holidays. The Lehigh Township yard waste center is for township residents only for the disposal of yard waste accumulated on their own residential property and is not to be brought to the site by way of commercial contractor. Commercial yard waste is not permitted at the Lehigh Township site. The access card is non-transferrable and shall not be given to another individual, household, resident, or any businesses.

Yard waste is considered to be unbagged leaves, tree branches, Christmas trees, and hedge clippings. The tree branches must be cut into 8-foot lengths and shall not be larger than 8 inches in diameter. These items are to be placed in the areas designated for these materials. Dried leaves and brush should not be mixed together. Do not place material in the green bins. They are only for the transportation of material to the FRCA site.

Residents may also pick up compost and mulch when the material is available.

The following material is not acceptable and cannot be dropped at the Lehigh Township site: Grass clippings*, ornamental grass, bamboo, sod, dirt, stones, cattails, hay, straw, nuts, large logs, root balls, stumps, wood, and construction material.

*Residents are encouraged to Grasscycle by leaving the grass clippings on their yard. If you do need to dispose of grass clippings, you may take the grass in containers to the main FRCA site at 6701 Weaversville Road, on Wednesdays and Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and the 1st & 3rd Saturday of the month from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. There is a \$1 per 32-gallon container charge. Please visit the FRCA website, www.frcauthority.org for additional information.

Since space at the site is limited, residents who have a large amount of yard waste are encouraged to take the material directly to FRCA. There is no charge for residents to go to the Weaversville Road site with proof of residency/identification.

The yard waste site is under video surveillance. Cards will be deactivated if the above regulations are not followed. A copy of your driver's license will be taken when applying for the access card.

I understand that my access to the yard waste site will be revoked if the above regulations are not followed.
