AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME, BY CHANGING SECTION 147-28 TO PROVIDE
FOR RECREATION FEES IN LIEU OF THE DEDICATION OF LAND IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE NUMBER OF DWELLING UNITS ASSOCIATED
WITH THE PLAN SUBMISSION AND BY MODIFYING THE RECREATION
FEES ASSOCIATED WITH NON-RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT.**

**IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS ENACTED AND
ORDAINED** as follows:

SECTION 1. The title block of Ordinance No. 2020-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEHIGH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
AMENDING THE LEHIGH TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT
ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 2002-1, AS CODIFIED AT CHAPTER 147 AND AS
AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME, BY CHANGING SECTION 147-28 TO PROVIDE
FOR RECREATION FEES IN LIEU OF THE DEDICATION OF LAND IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE NUMBER OF DWELLING UNITS ASSOCIATED
WITH THE PLAN SUBMISSION AND BY MODIFYING THE RECREATION
FEES ASSOCIATED WITH NON-RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT.**

SECTION 2: Severability. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Township that such remainder shall be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: Repealer. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby and the same repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its final passage and adoption.
