

Resolution 2021- 9

A Resolution of Lehigh Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania Establishing Election Integrity

The Board of Supervisors of Lehigh Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves that the following election integrity laws will be adhered to throughout the Lehigh Township community and the polls.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township, Northampton County, is a second class township that supports, defends and upholds the constitutionality of the United States Constitution and the Pennsylvania Constitution.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township recognizes the Pennsylvania Election Code prior to the unconstitutional passing and adoption of Act 77 and the 2020 Act 12.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township requests Northampton County to clean the voter rolls from deceased electors and non-residents of Lehigh Township one month prior to every primary and general elections.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township will require electors to present photo identification that shows name and current address at the polls to vote.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township will require electors to verify their signature at the polls and on absentee ballots prior to voting.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township will not permit same day voter registration and voting on Election Day at the polls.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township will not permit drop boxes in the Township.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township does recognize absentee ballots for voters who are permitted to vote by absentee ballot due to illness or absent in the Township due to work related reasons during Election Day. Absentee ballots must be received and postmarked two weeks prior to Election Day.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township does not recognize mail-in ballots and will not permit mass mailing of voter registration applications and mail-in ballots into residents of Lehigh Township.

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township will not permit ballot pre-canvassing, canvassing of absentee ballots and canvassing of mail-in ballots of the electors.
