

RESOLUTION 2022-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LEHIGH TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, REQUESTING GRANT FUNDING FOR UPGRADES AND ENHANCEMENTS TO THEIR RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM THROUGH PENNSYLVANIA COMMISSION ON CRIME AND DELINQUENCY AND AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR SAID GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Lehigh Township Police Department desires to apply for grant funding for a Multiple Agency Records Management System Upgrade project through the Local Law Enforcement Grant Program by Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency; and

WHEREAS, the Lehigh Township Police Department's existing records management system has become outdated; and


WHEREAS, Lehigh Township Police Department desires to upgrade their records management system to cNET; and

WHEREAS, Lehigh Township Police Department and cNET recognize the need for programs upgrades and said upgrades benefit multiple law enforcement agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, it shall be and here is resolved as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Lehigh Township, Northampton County is officially requesting grant funding in the amount of \$378,200 through the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency Local Law Enforcement Grant Program to be used for obtaining a new upgraded records management system
2. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorized the Chief of Police as the official to apply for funding through the Local Law Enforcement Grant Program
3. The Board of Supervisors supports the application for grant funding for an upgraded records management system;
